WE HEAR GOD'S WORD

Scripture Reading: Psalm 73 (P:539)

¹Surely God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart. ² But as for me, my feet had almost slipped; I had nearly lost my foothold.³ For I envied the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.⁴ They have no struggles; their bodies are healthy and strong. ⁵ They are free from common human burdens; they are not plagued by human ills.⁶ Therefore pride is their necklace; they clothe themselves with violence.⁷ From their callous hearts comes iniquity their evil imaginations have no limits.⁸ They scoff, and speak with malice; with arrogance they threaten oppression.⁹ Their mouths lay claim to heaven, and their tongues take possession of the earth.¹⁰ Therefore their people turn to them and drink up waters in abundance.¹¹ They say, "How would God know? Does the Most High know anything?"¹² This is what the wicked are like— always free of care, they go on amassing wealth.¹³ Surely in vain I have kept my heart pure and have washed my hands in innocence. ¹⁴ All day long I have been afflicted, and every morning brings new punishments.¹⁵ If I had spoken out like that, I would have betrayed your children.¹⁶ When I tried to understand all this, it troubled me deeply¹⁷ till I entered the sanctuary of God; then I understood their final destiny.¹⁸ Surely you

place them on slippery ground; you cast them down to ruin.¹⁹ How suddenly are they destroyed, completely swept away by terrors!²⁰ They are like a dream when one awakes; when you arise, Lord, you will despise them as fantasies.²¹ When my heart was grieved and my spirit embittered,²² I was senseless and ignorant; I was a brute beast before you.²³ Yet I am always with you; you hold me by my right hand.²⁴ You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will take me into glory.²⁵ Whom have I in heaven but you? And earth has nothing I desire besides you.²⁶ My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.²⁷ Those who are far from you will perish; you destroy all who are unfaithful to you.²⁸ But as for me, it is good to be near God. I have made the Sovereign LORD my refuge; I will tell of all your deeds.
